Things I will need:

2. Ensure that your wedding planner lines up the wedding party in the order you want them announced. I don't find people and line people up because I don't know them or know what they look like.
3. How do you want to be announced? Mr. & Mrs. \_\_\_\_\_?
4. I would like all info at least or before two weeks before your date. All info needs to be solid. Last minute changes are not favorable for obvious reasons.
